Get the App

Download the Shot Insights app from your phone's app store. Or simply scan the QR code below.

Create an Account.

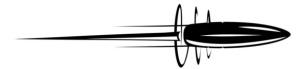
Your session data, ballistic profiles, and adopted devices will be tied to your account so you can view across different tablets or phones.

Create a Ballistic Profile

Create a ballistic profile by entering your rifle, ammo, and environment info. You can use this data on the range with QuickSight — even without ShotCaller hardware.

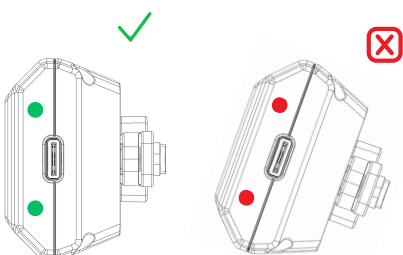

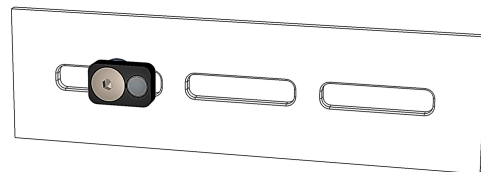
Installing the Hub.

Installing the hub on your rifle is simple. Start by mounting the hub key to your rifle using the M-LOK system — it's slim enough to stay on even when ShotCaller isn't in use. When you attach the hub, position it so the level lights on the bottom are clearly visible while you're behind the scope.

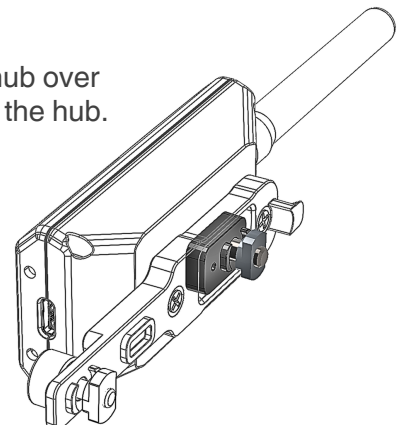
Level Indicator:



Install the key in the orientation below, the screw should be forward of the magnet



When you Install the hub over the key, it will activate the hub.



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05. Installing Target Mounts

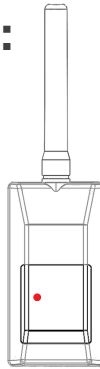
Apply the Velcro to your steel target in a spot that protects the device from the line of fire. Check for clearance when the steel swings to avoid contact with the hanger. Velcro strengthens with use—attach and remove it a few times to season it. After installing the mount, give it a slight twist to lock it in securely.

- Event Indicated

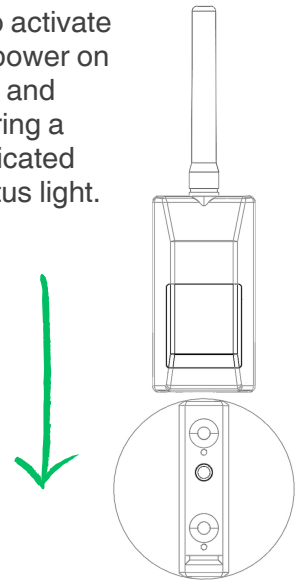
Charging Indicator:

06. Activating the Target

Simply slide the target device onto the mount to activate it. It should power on immediately and begin acquiring a GPS fix. Indicated by a red status light.



08. Using the App

The app connects to the hub automatically. On first connection, confirm when prompted to adopt the device.

If it doesn't connect, make sure Bluetooth is on and the app has permission. If the Bluetooth icon is black on the home screen, tap it to rescan—it turns off automatically to save battery.

Once the hub is connected and has a GPS fix, the Range feature will unlock. As target devices get GPS, you'll be prompted to adopt them. Adopted targets will appear on the map—tap one to see distance and hold data.
